- Essays must be typed and be between 500 and 750 words in length
- The student's name should appear only on the official Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest entry form, which must be stapled to the essay
- All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned
- Entrants must be registered Parishioners of either St Elizabeth Ann Seton or St Leo the Great Parishes and "Not attending a Catholic School."
- Children only, no grandchildren
- Children enrolled in Catholic schools other than Teurlings Catholic High School or Sts Leo Seton Catholic School are not eligible for Council 5345's essay contest.
- Entrants must fill out both a Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest form and a Council 5345 Entry Form and submit a photocopy of their school ID for verification. Home school students are also welcomed.
- 1st and 2nd place will be awarded to each grade level with \$100 to the 1st place finisher and \$50 to the 2nd place finisher
- There will also be an overall 1st Place Winner with a prize of \$200
- Winners will further compete at the state level, with the possibility of competing at the national level
