



JESUS I TRUST IN YOU

The passion of Jesus finds its purpose in His Resurrection – Easter Glory! Jesus wants us to each partake in His Glory. Jesus is offering to each of us the gift of His love and mercy. The culmination of this offering is found in the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday, which we celebrate one week following Jesus’ Resurrection. Appearing to Saint Faustina, Jesus called for His image of Mercy to be venerated. Of this Jesus said: “...**by means of this Image I shall be granting many graces to souls.**” (Diary 570). “**My gaze from this Image is like My gaze from the cross.**” (Diary 326). “...**I desire that this Image be displayed in public on the first Sunday after Easter. That Sunday is the Feast of Mercy. Through the Word Incarnate, I make known the bottomless depth of My Mercy.**” (Diary 88). “**I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: ‘Jesus, I trust in You.’**”

We wish to honor Jesus’s request and make His image present to as many as possible. Each family has been gifted with a ‘yard sign’ of Jesus’s Divine Mercy image.

It was the desire of Jesus that this image be venerated throughout the world, and He proclaimed, “**I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I, myself will defend it as my own glory.**” (Diary 47-48)

Let us heed this heavenly desire, at a time when the world is in desperate need, by flooding our community with His sacred image as a witness of our abiding faith in His promise. By our personal participation, we will be doing our part to open our hearts to His mercy and bring hope to others in the process who will gaze on the image in our respective yards. Together, let’s generate a powerful movement beckoning Jesus’ Divine Mercy!!!!
