BAPTISM

Registration during the early stages of pregnancy for the Baptism course is strongly recommended.

CONFIRMATION

All students, including those in public and Catholic schools, register in August of their eighth-junior year of school. Call the office for registration requirements.

FIRST PENANCE AND FIRST COMMUNION

All children, including those in public and Catholic schools, register at the beginning of their second grade in order to participate in the sacramental preparation.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (1st thru 11th grades, including Confirmation)

- Registration for all sections of Religious Education is in August
- First through seventh grades Religious Education classes meet on Sundays at 2:45 – 4:00PM.
- Confirmation classes meet on Sunday 4:00 – 5:45PM.
- Vacation Bible School, for children ages 4-10, is held for one week each summer, when scheduled.
- Adults wishing to learn more about their Catholic faith, including those wishing to become members of the Catholic Church, should call the office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

The church can be reserved only after meeting with the Priest/Deacon to begin marriage preparation for the couple. It is recommended that an appointment be made one (1) year in advance of the anticipated date of the wedding. Marriage preparation requirements, policies and guidelines are reviewed and must be completed prior to any marriage in the church.

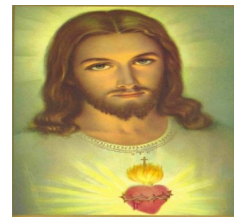

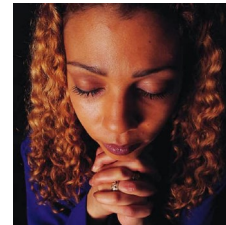

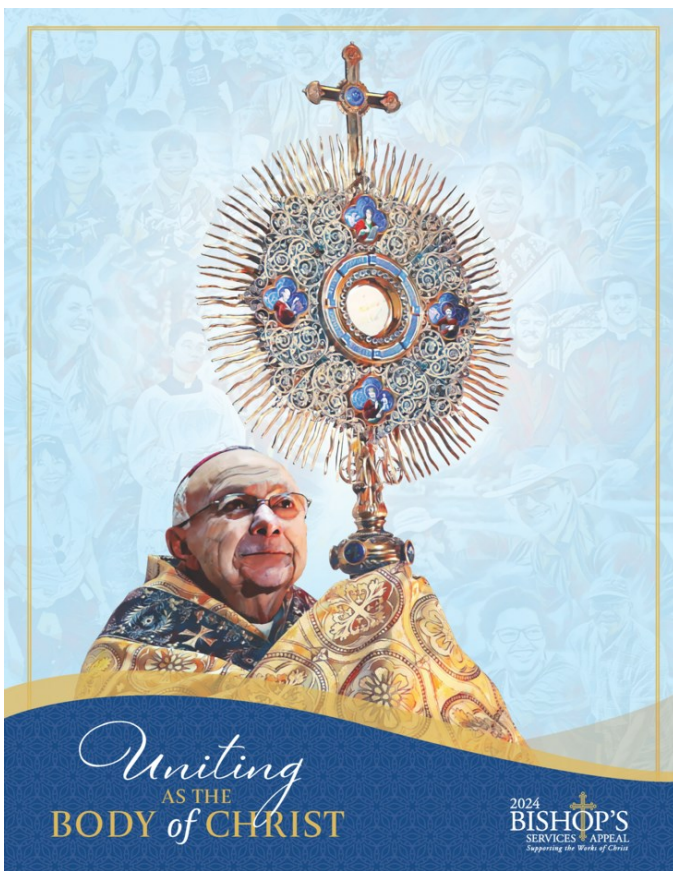

SEMINARIAN MISSION FUND

Every year the seminarians from Notre Dame Seminary (New Orleans, La.) and St. Joseph Seminary (Covington, La.) go on mission trips to spread the word of Christ and rebuild communities in need. These trips provide seminarians the opportunity to experience the missionary dimension of a pastoral ministry, and these trips are a required part of their priestly formation.

To help fund these mission trips, the Louisiana State Council established the Seminarian Mission Fund. The net proceeds from the fund are donated to Notre Dame Seminary and St. Joseph Seminary to finance the costs of the mission trips. You can support the Seminarian Mission Fund by making a monetary donation or by purchasing and selling Seminarian Mission Fund raffle tickets.
